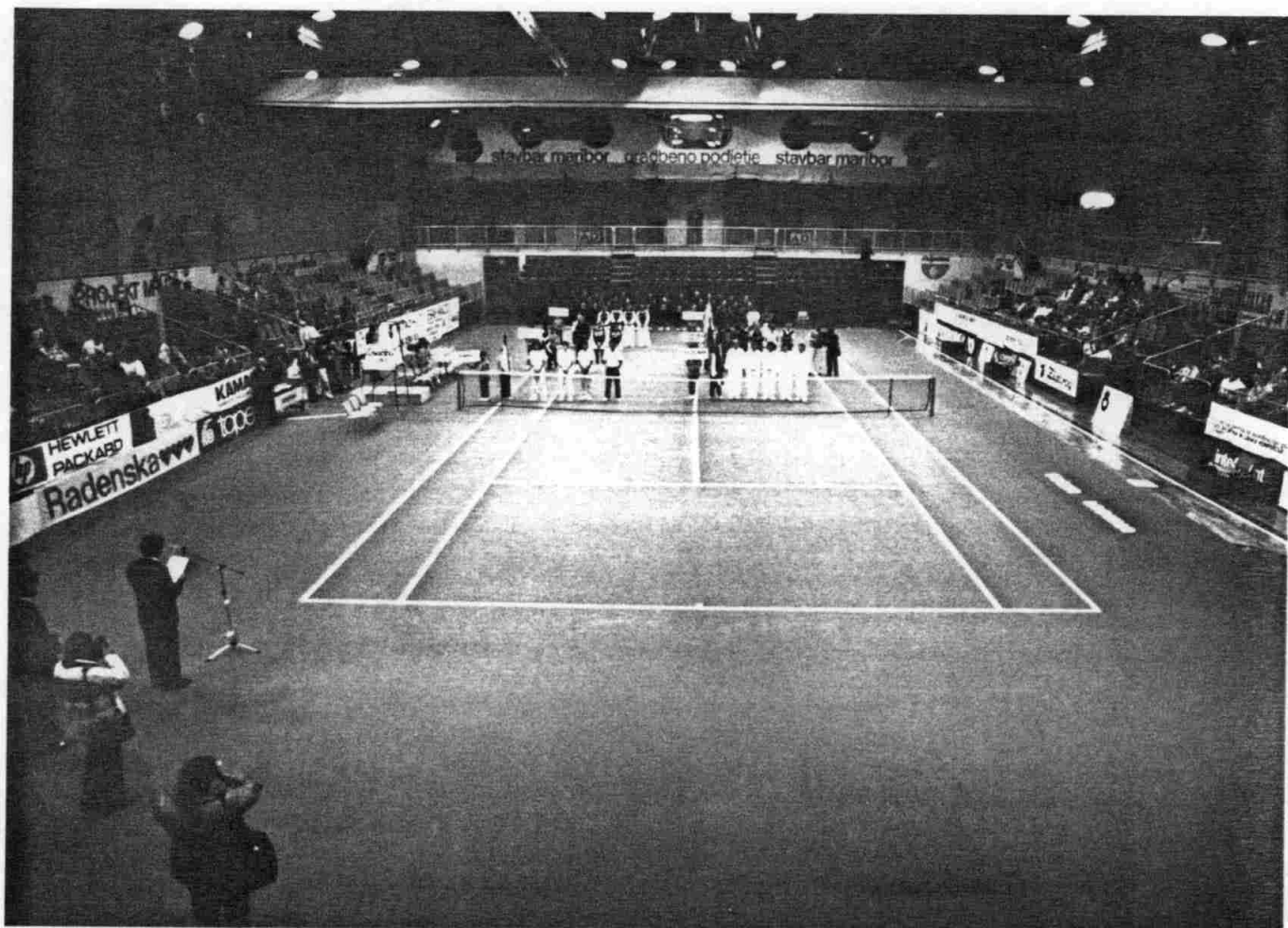

REGULATIONS

RECOMMENDATIONS AND PROPOSALS

From France:

Suggests revision of deadline for players nominations to ensure that nominated players be really those competing in the Event. An anticipated nomination may also heavily effect the seeding.

Comment: technically no problem to have the draw made on site the week of the Event but this solution faces two basic difficulties:

- no promotion possible of the Event with the names of unominated players
- no possibility for the Organizers to fix the schedule of play in advance (mainly for TV purposes).

The solution, also under evaluation for the Opel European Cup, could be to seed (like in the Davis Cup) for Division 1 the finalists of the previous edition; for the other Divisions the relegated Team from the upper Division and the runner-up from the previous year in the same Division. The other Nations to be drawn by lot.

From the Swiss Captain N. Kelaidis:

Suggests to change the system presently adopted for ranking the teams in each Group and to select the ones which have to play in the relegation tie. He would like to keep in account the head to head result between the two teams with worse performances.

Comment: the system cannot work because the two only possible alternatives are the following:

Alt. A: 1 team with two wins
 2 team with one win
 3 team with zero win

Alt. B: like in Eindhoven all the three teams scored one win, therefore how to establish the team for the relegation play-off?
A d B 3-0 B d C 2-1 C d A 2-1
A 4 matches won
C 3 matches won
B 2 matches won

According to Kelaidis proposal C would have to play in the relegation play-off even if the team scored more wins in individual matches. In the case of three teams with 1 win and with three 3-0 wins you should again account on sets and games to establish the ranking. Playing in the Relegation Play-off does not automatically mean Relegation!

Comments and Authorizations requested from Referees and Event Directors:

- L. Nyiroe (Division 1):

Doubles of the Final must be played in any case when the result has been achieved in favour of a Nation?
Also after the Prize-giving Ceremony?

(For relegation play-off it is normal practice not to insist on the doubles to be played once the result has been achieved after the singles).

- F. Reicher (Division 3):

Relegation play-off to be played in other location and on a different day (with the agreement of the captains).

-- G. Martini (Division 3):

Suggested revision of ITF Code of Conduct (natural loss of physical condition).

Clarifications requested from Executive Director:

Attitude towards Poland: withdrawal on 3/10/86 due to "financial, travelling and sports reasons".

Relegation from Division 3: criteria for qualifying Event (or Division 4 in the following year).

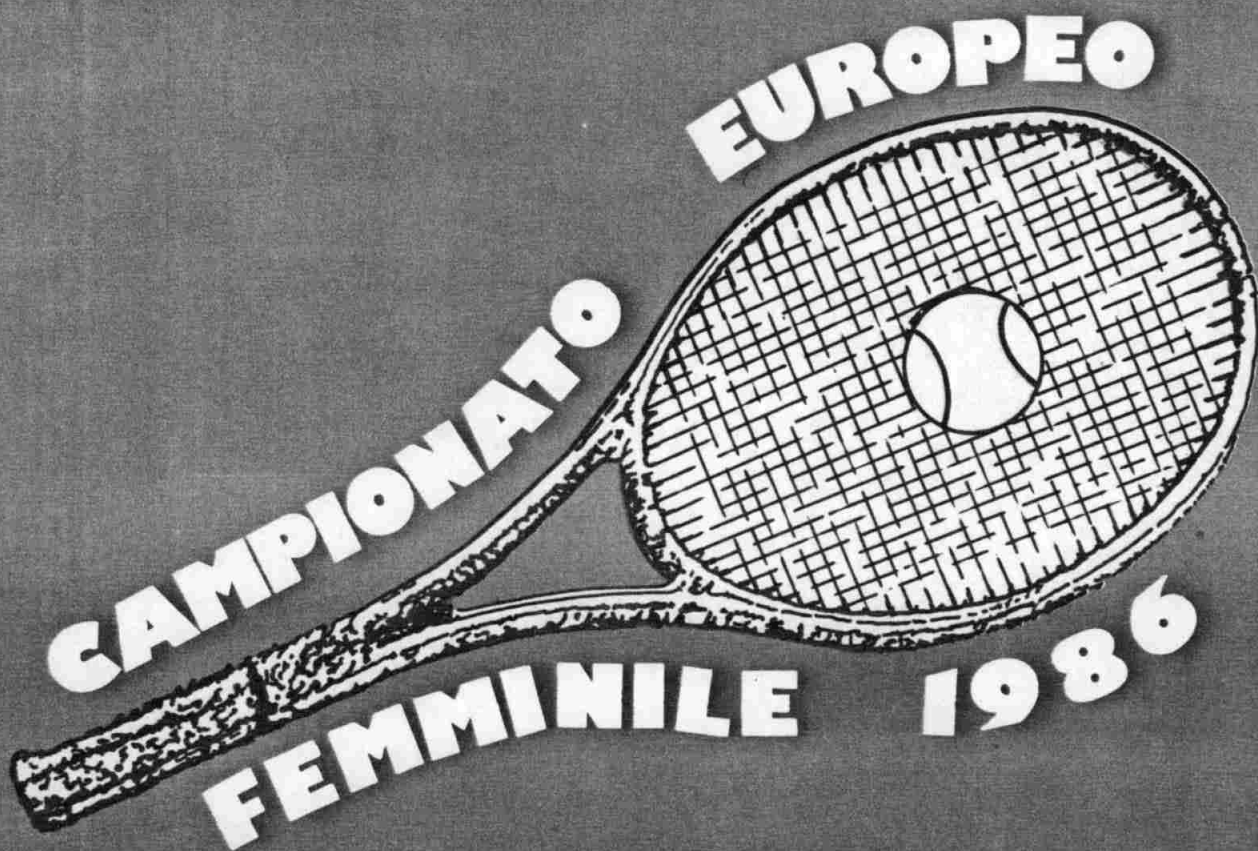

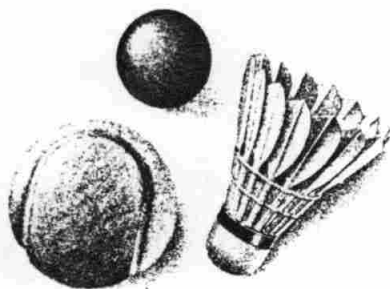
