INTRODUCTION

It is with pleasure that I submit my report of the 1991 European Women's Team Championship.

Overall, a very successful competition, due in no small way to the organisation provided by our four host Nations, i.e. France (Nantes); Czechoslovakia (Pruhonice); Spain (Mallorca), and Hungary (Keszthely). We are indebted to all those involved, and who made all the players feel most welcome at each venue.

The 1991 competition was not, unfortunately, without some difficulties regarding the late withdrawal of several teams. In Division I, the USSR had to withdraw at the very last moment due to the team members being unable to obtain visas. In Division III, Yugoslavia were forced to pull out, due to their National problems, and in Division IV, Malta were unable to send a full team. These withdrawals caused a change of format in Divisions III and IV where a Round Robin was played.

In the following pages, you will find detailed information concerning the 1991 event.

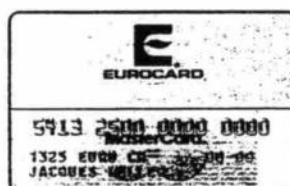
